WHAT SHOULD YOU BE DOING NOW TO PREPARE FOR COLLEGE OR VO-TECH

- 1. Set up FSA ID for both parent and student at www.pin.ed.gov.
- 2. Complete FAFSA application online at www.fafsa.ed.gov to apply for financial aid and TOPS.
- 3. Apply for scholarships
- 4. Touch base with college or vo-tech that you plan to attend to make sure everything is squared away.
- 5. Touch base with financial aid office of college or vo-tech to see what is available for you.
- 6. Complete LOSFA Consent Form in counselors' office if you haven't done so.

<u>CPR TRAINING</u> – All Seniors must take CPR before they graduate. CPR training will be offered by Coach Henagan at 1st and 3rd blocks on the following dates: April 5, May 3 Sign up in main office if you need this.

<u>NCAA</u> - To play college sports, you must register with NCAA. If you qualify for free or reduced lunch, there is a waiver for the registration fee.
